The Facts

The Country Fair is organised by Allington Hillbilly Volunteers in partnership with Bridport Town Council

The event is celebrating the 40th anniversary of the community raising the money to purchase Allington Hill.

The Country Fair will be held on Saturday the 2nd of May 2026, 10am-4pm, in Cooper's Field, North Allington (area leased by Bridport Town Council).

The ethos behind the event.

Free entry. There should be no financial barrier for anyone attending.

Free or affordable activities and have a go sessions for all ages, based on country crafts and activities.

Support local businesses and volunteer groups whose activities are based in traditional country crafts.

Funding

This is a one off event. We will be applying for grants, funding and sponsorship. Other monies will be raised through pitch fees, fund raising and asking for donations at key venues on site.

Pitch application.

When you sign the application for a pitch, you are agreeing to...

Only taking up the allocated space. Follow all instructions given by Marshalls for unloading and loading of equipment and goods. All vehicles to enter and leave at allotted times.

Stalls to be ready 30 minutes before official opening time.

No music to be played from stalls. All rubbish you generate must be removed from site.

(Please note this is an open access site. People will be able to enter the grounds before the official opening time.)

Provide a risk assessment for your activities. You are responsible for the welfare of your staff/ volunteers and visitors whilst on your stall.

Insurance.

You must have public liability insurance at the time of the event. If you are selling items we highly recommend that you have insurance in case of cancellation, due to bad weather, or unforeseen circumstances. Neither the Allington Hillbilly Volunteers, nor Bridport Town Council will cover for any loss of earnings, perishable goods or out of pocket expenses.

If funding allows, you may be able to apply for funds to help cover the cost of materials for free have a go sessions.

Marshalls

There will be Marshalls, First Aid tent and information centre on site during the event.

Programme of events

Times of events and activities will be organised by the volunteer group and Bridport Town Council and are non negotiable. Signage around the site and programmes will be available at entry points.

Promoting you
